POSTING EMERGENCY INFORMATION

Post your home phone and mobile phone numbers, spouse's work numbers and your home address by each of your telephones. Include the 999 emergency number at the top. In an emergency you or your guests don't want to have to go searching for those very important numbers.

TVAWC has a form you can post on your refrigerator that tells EMS your local and international contacts, medications, etc.

REGISTER WITH THE AMERICAN EMBASSY

Travel registration is a free service provided by the U.S. Government to U.S. citizens who are traveling to, or living in, a foreign country. Registration allows you to record information about your upcoming trip abroad that the Department of State can use to assist you in case of an emergency. Americans residing abroad can also get routine information from the nearest U.S. Embassy or Consulate. This can be done at:
